School Overview

The Village School of Naples began as The Caring Place Preschool in 1985 as an outreach at North Naples United Methodist Church. In 2000, the church relocated to the present campus and added the K-5 elementary school. In 2006, TVS was accredited by the Florida Council of Independent Schools and later became a member of the National Association of Independent Schools. In 2009, the Middle School was created, adopted a STEAM centered curriculum and TVS became the first certified independent STEAM school in Collier county. In August 2016, the Upper School was established with a robust college preparatory program which included college visits, career fairs and impressive ACT & SAT practice test results.
